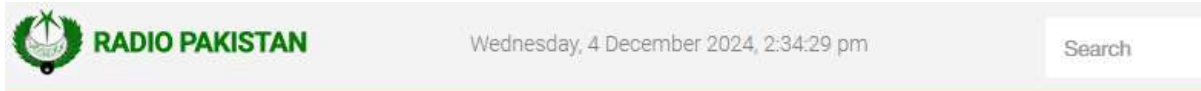

Calling Youth the “Ambassadors of Pakistan,” he urged them to work hard honestly and glorify the name of Pakistan.



Dr. Yasmin Rashid demands accountability for 'atrocities' against PTI workers

LAHORE: Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) senior leader Dr. Yasmin Rashid, during an informal conversation in the Jinnah Convention Centre, strongly condemned the actions of the Peshawar government calling it a shameful chapter in the country's history.

Dr. Rashid criticized the Chief Minister of Punjab, stating, "The Chief Minister should be subjected to inquiry. With time, Punjab, you did not come out. We have faced such cruelty in the history of Pakistan." She further decried the alleged brutality inflicted on PTI workers and emphasized that such acts are against humanity.

Addressing the crowd, Dr. Rashid reiterated her commitment to democratic protesting. "In our government, we allowed protests, including long marches led by Mushtaq Fatmi, Ishaq Dar, Haseeb Jinnah, and Maryam Nawaz. As a minister, I said that protest is a constitutionally guaranteed right, and we upheld that right."

The PTI leader vowed to hold those responsible for the alleged human rights violations accountable. "The PTI will hold account of the cruelty on each and every one of its workers," she said.

Dr. Rashid also announced her intention to write a letter to the Chief Justice of Pakistan, urging the formation of a judicial commission to investigate the matter. "These lives will be accounted for," she declared, asserting the need for justice and accountability.

Police officer among three shot dead in Lakki Marwat

LAHORE: At least three individuals, including a police officer, were shot dead in Lakki Marwat, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

In a separate incident, the victim included Sub-Inspector Qasim Khan, who was stationed in Faisalabad, and two other individuals who were father and son.

According to police reports, unknown assailants opened fire on the victims, who were visiting Lakki Marwat for holidays. The motive behind the attack is still unclear, and an investigation is underway to apprehend those responsible.

Earlier, at least two men, including a policeman in his uniform, were shot dead in a separate incident in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

In yet another case, an explosion rocked the area of Toba Tek Singh, which claimed the life of one whereas the second died occurred in the locality of Police Station Lower Mohmand having one policeman martyred.

Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has seen a rampant rise in such incidents in the past few days.

On November 20, at least twelve security personnel sustained injuries in a suicide attack on check post in Bannu, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

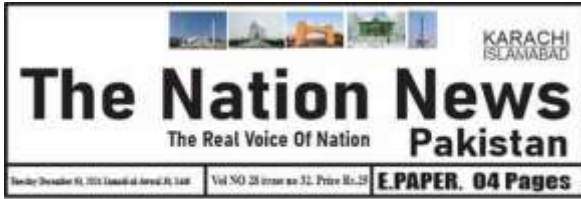

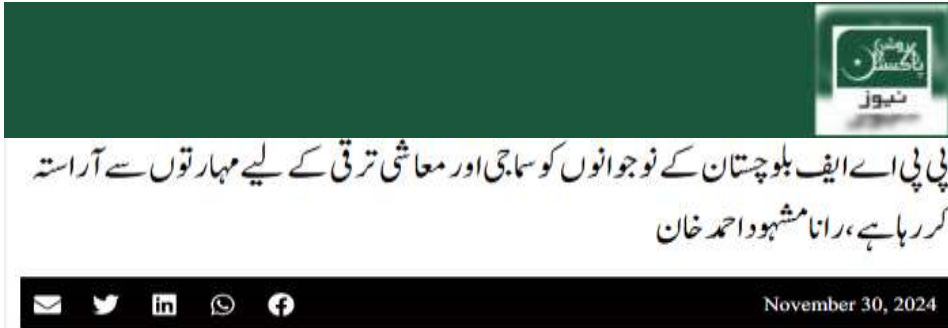
