Federal Minister Syed Imran Ahmad Shah Inaugurates Solarized Water Filtration Plant in Sahiwal, Reaffirms Government's Commitment to Climate-Resilient Community Development

Federal Minister for Poverty Alleviation and Social Safety, Syed Imran Ahmad Shah, inaugurated a solarized water filtration plant at Village Daad Baloch, Union Council Karyal-1, Sahiwal, under the Building Resilient Communities for Sustainable Development (BRCSD) Project being implemented by the Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF) through its partner organization, Comprehensive Health and Education Forum (CHEF). The ceremony was attended by Member Provincial Assembly Pir Wilayat Shah Khagga, Chief Executive Officer of PPAF Mr. Nadir Gul Barech, Chief Executive Officer of CHEF International Mr. Sohail Ayaz Khan, Dr. Ahmad Khawar Shahzad, senior officials from PPAF and CHEF, and members of the local community.

Addressing the gathering as Chief Guest, Federal Minister Syed Imran Ahmad Shah said that ensuring access to safe drinking water, especially for rural and climate-vulnerable communities, remains a priority of the Government of Pakistan. He highlighted that climate change is increasing pressure on water resources, making climate-resilient infrastructure essential for public health, livelihoods, and community resilience.

The Minister appreciated PPAF's contribution to poverty alleviation and inclusive development, noting its outreach across 150 districts and its impact on nearly 18 million people as a reflection of its commitment to empowering communities through sustainable initiatives. He also commended PPAF's development interventions and flood response in Sahiwal, including relief assistance, healthcare services, and livestock support.

Federal minister assures support for journalists

Federal Minister for Poverty Alleviation and Social Safety, Syed Irfan Ahmad Shah, and Member of the Punjab Assembly Malik Arshad visited the Sahiwal Press Club, where they assured the journalist community of resolving their genuine issues and extending every possible support for the development of the Press Club. The Federal Minister said that from 2008 to 2026, the Pakistan Muslim League (N) had transformed Sahiwal into a divisional headquarters and launched development projects worth billions of rupees.

Upon their arrival at the Sahiwal Press Club, President Rana Javed Nisar and members of the club warmly welcomed the dignitaries and presented them with bouquets. Addressing a press conference, Syed Irfan Ahmad Shah and Malik Arshad stated that the PML-N leadership had invested billions of rupees in Sahiwal's infrastructure, sewerage system, clean drinking water projects, road network, and education sector.

They highlighted that a Medical College, Teaching Hospital, and Cardiology

Department had been established in Sahiwal, where angioplasty procedures are being successfully performed. They further revealed that the summary for the proposed Mother and Child Hospital has already been forwarded to the Chief Minister's Office for approval.

The Federal Minister and Chairman of the Punjab Assembly Standing Committee on Parliamentary Affairs, Malik Arshad, termed the demand for a Journalists' Colony justified and announced that a requisition would soon be presented in the relevant meeting. Responding to a question, Syed Irfan Ahmad Shah said that efforts were also underway to secure approval for a motorway interchange in Sahiwal.

He emphasized that the government's top priorities include providing clean drinking water, strengthening social protection programs, and equipping young people with vocational skills to create employment opportunities. During the press conference, Malik Arshad said that journalists are the eyes and ears of society and that their issues would be resolved without discrimination.

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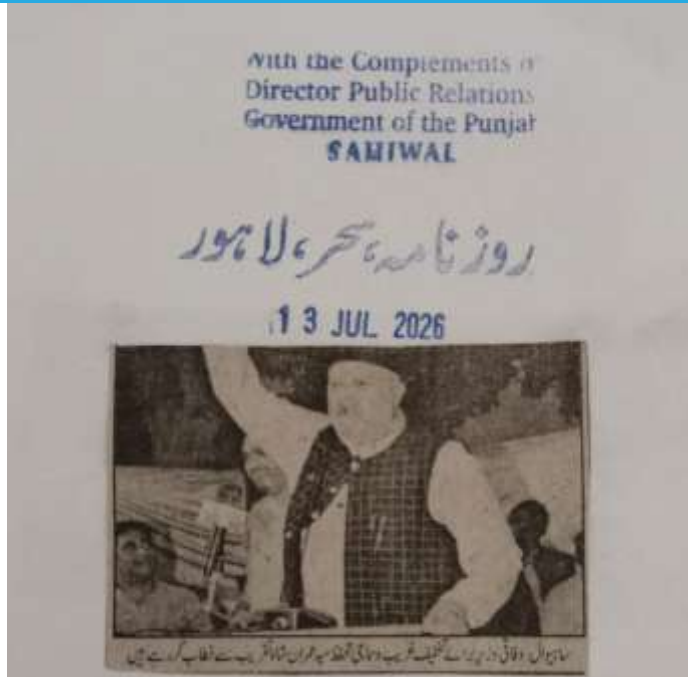
