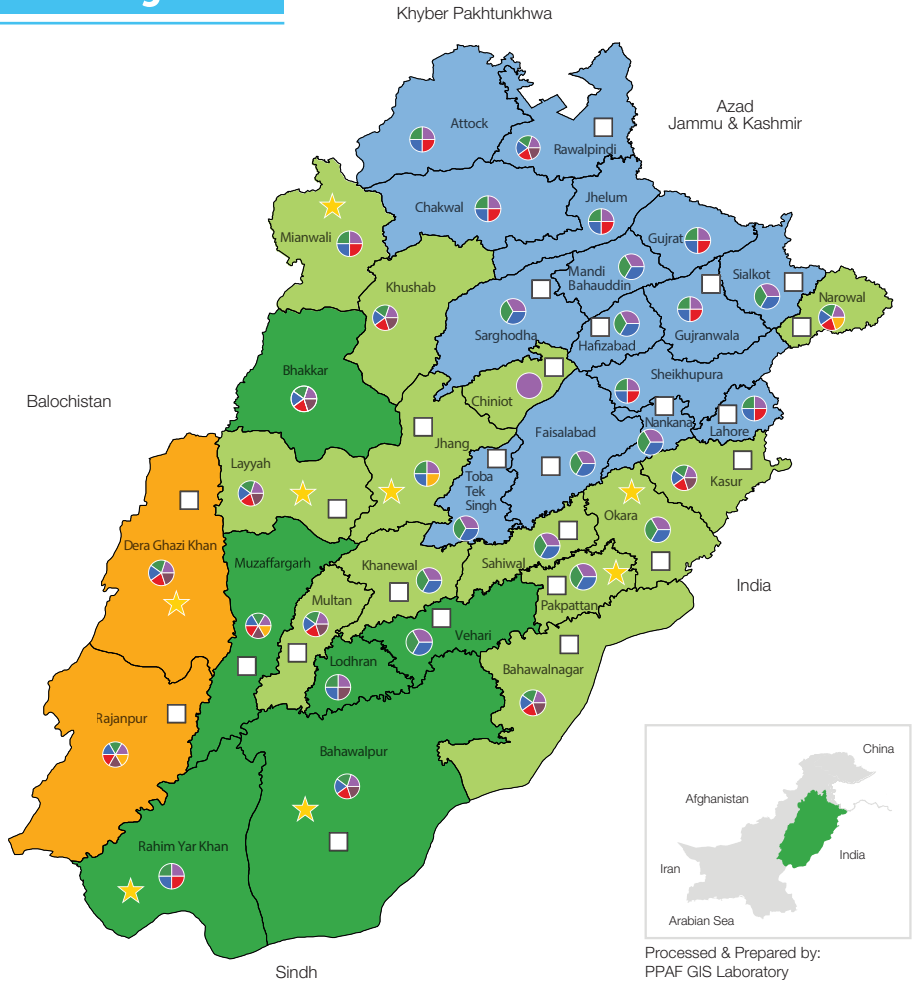

### LOCALISING DEVELOPMENT

**1.09 million** households organised, fostering social capital through a grassroots network of

**67,600** Community Institutions.



### FINANCIAL SUPPORT

**2.86 million** interest free loans disbursed under the Prime Minister's Interest Free Loan Programme (59% loans to women).



### CAPACITY BUILDING

**145,700** individuals (57% women) received enterprise and skills training.



### EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT

**63,600** students (48% girls) enrolled in  
**390** educational facilities.



### LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT

**47,800** ultra and vulnerable poor households (66% women beneficiaries).

**5.13 million** individuals (50% women) benefited from

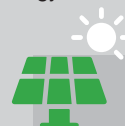
**9,050** water and infrastructure projects.
