

POST-FLOOD RESILIENT RECOVERY AND STRENGTHENING OF THE LIVESTOCK SECTOR IN BALOCHISTAN

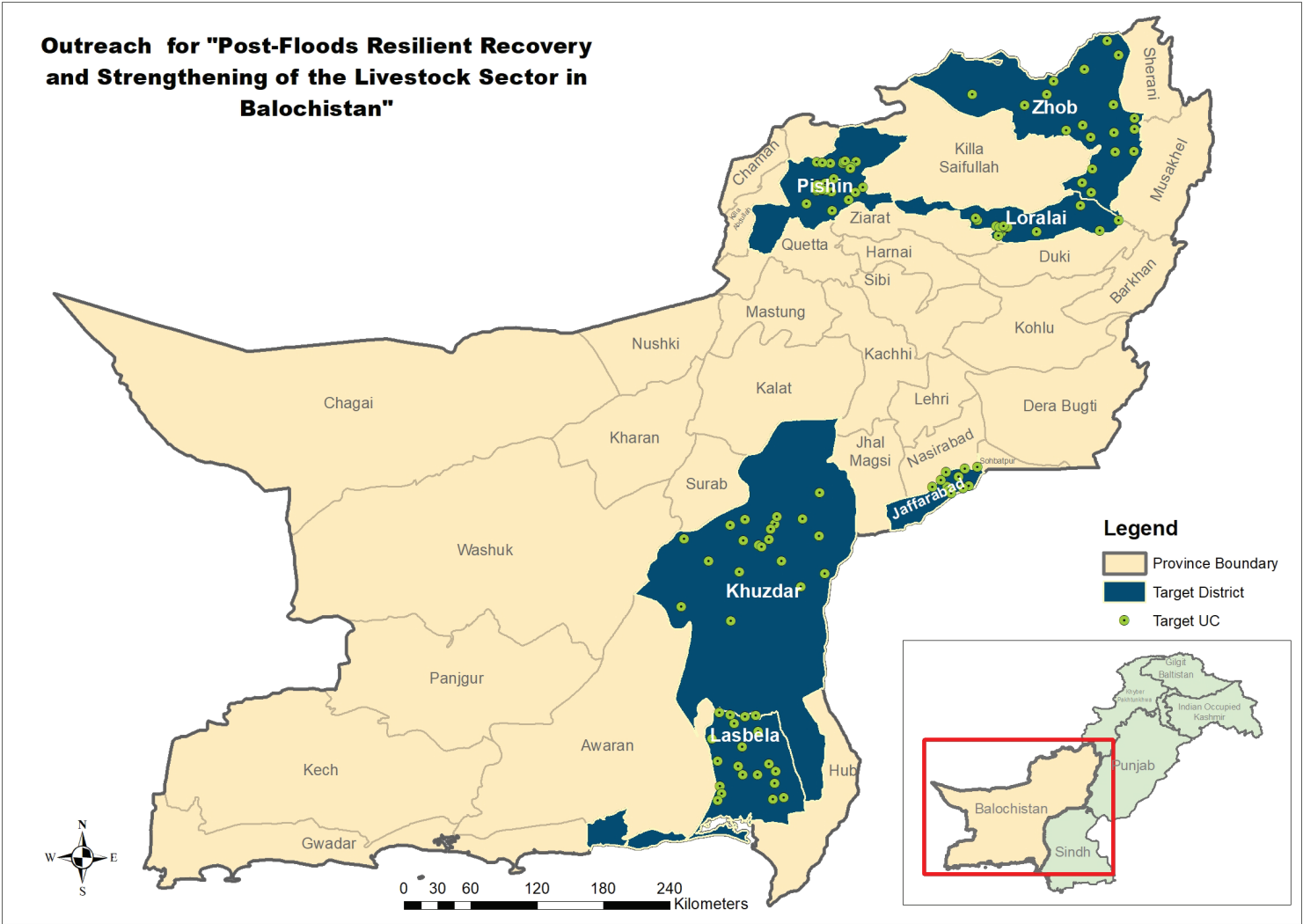

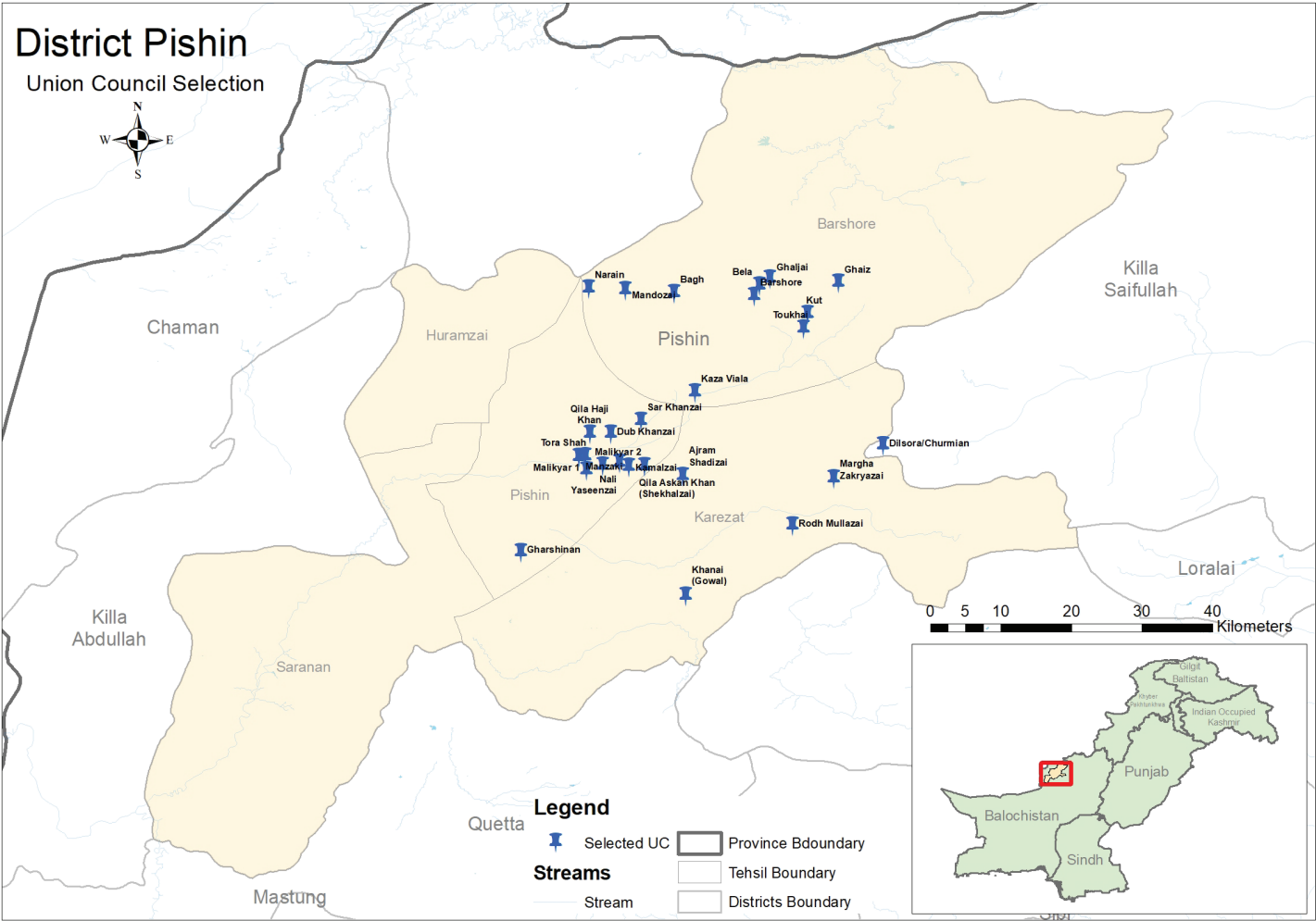
COVERAGE

(Pishin, Loralai, Zhob, Lasbela, Khuzdar, Jaffarabad)

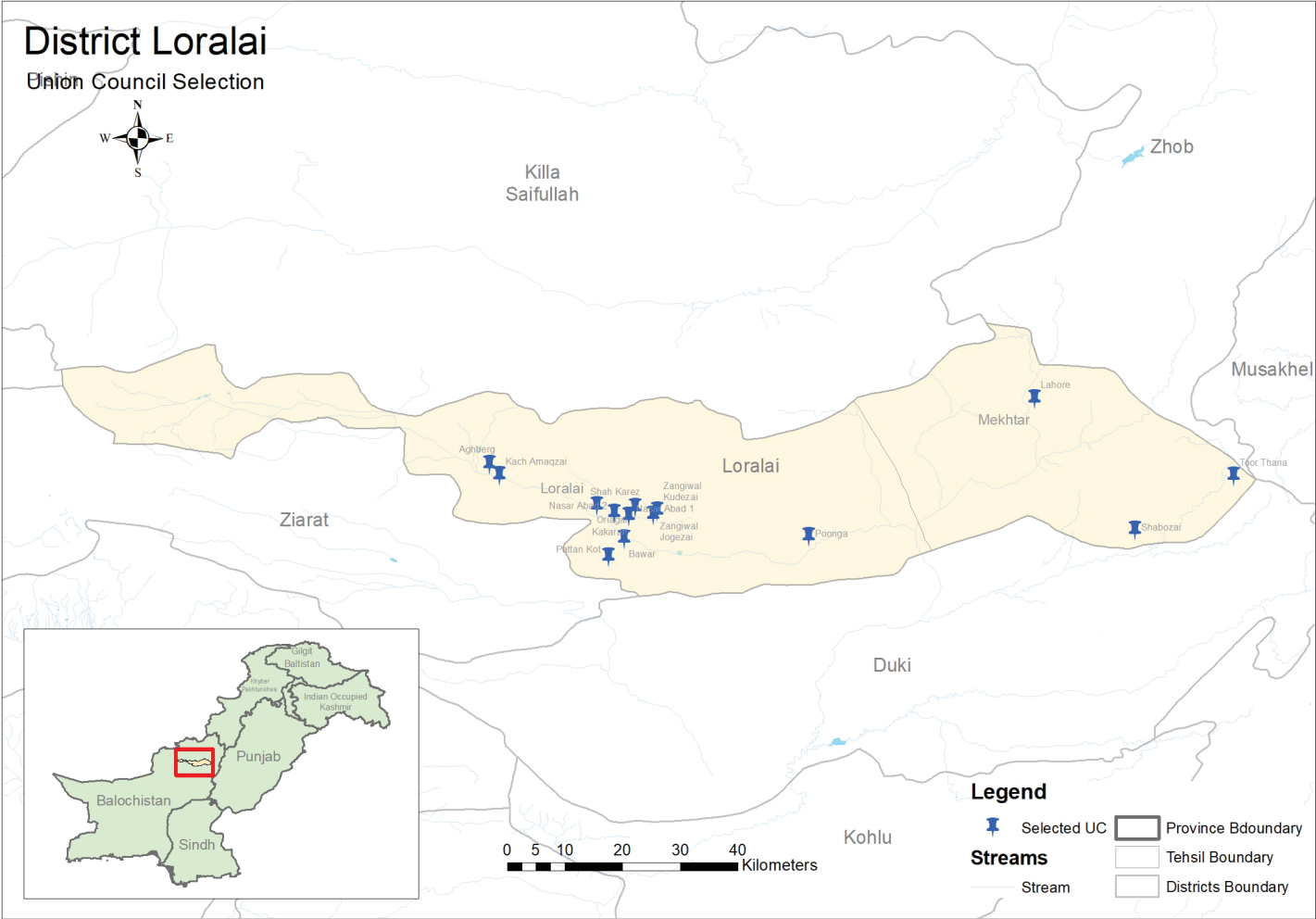

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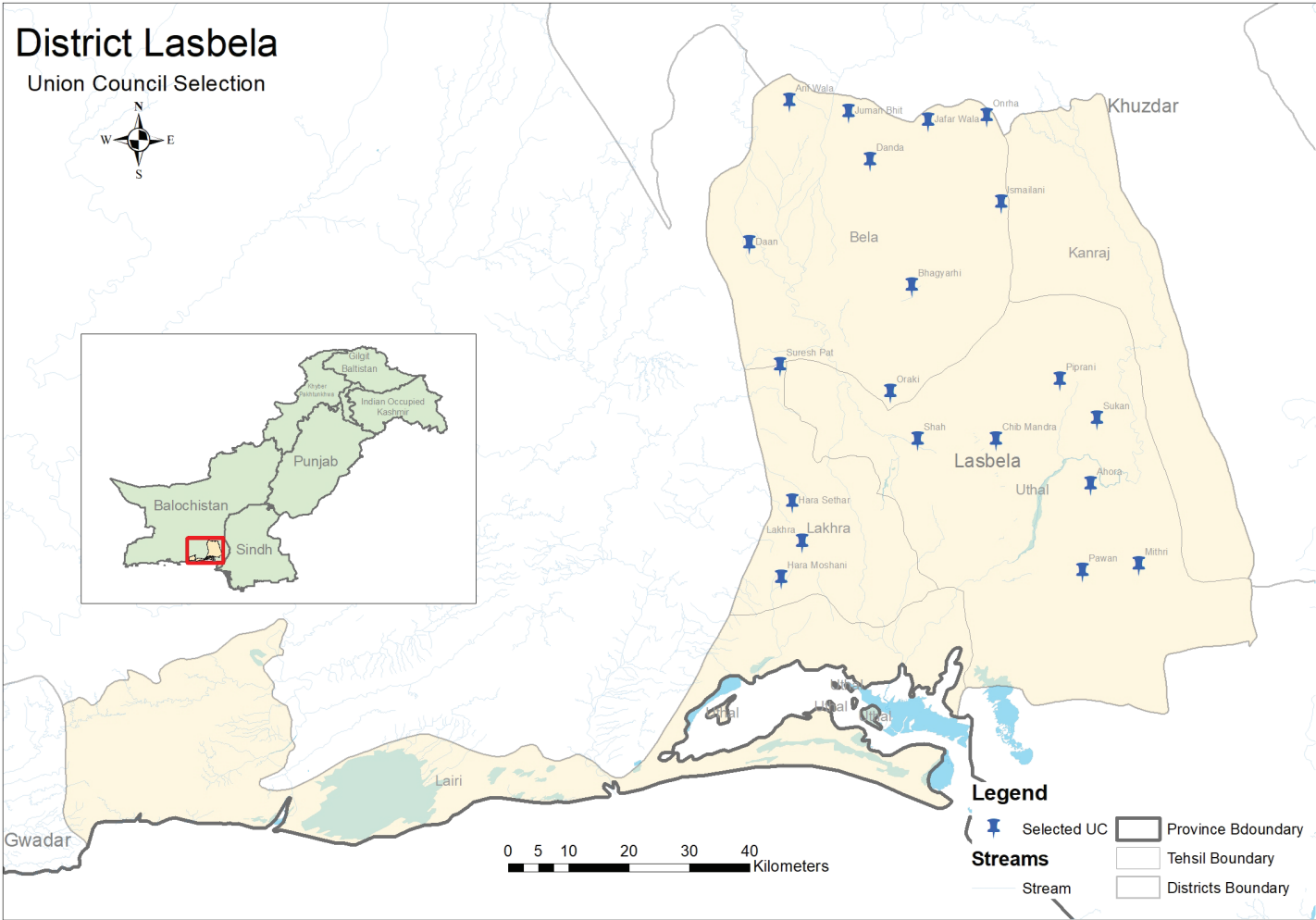


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District Lasbela

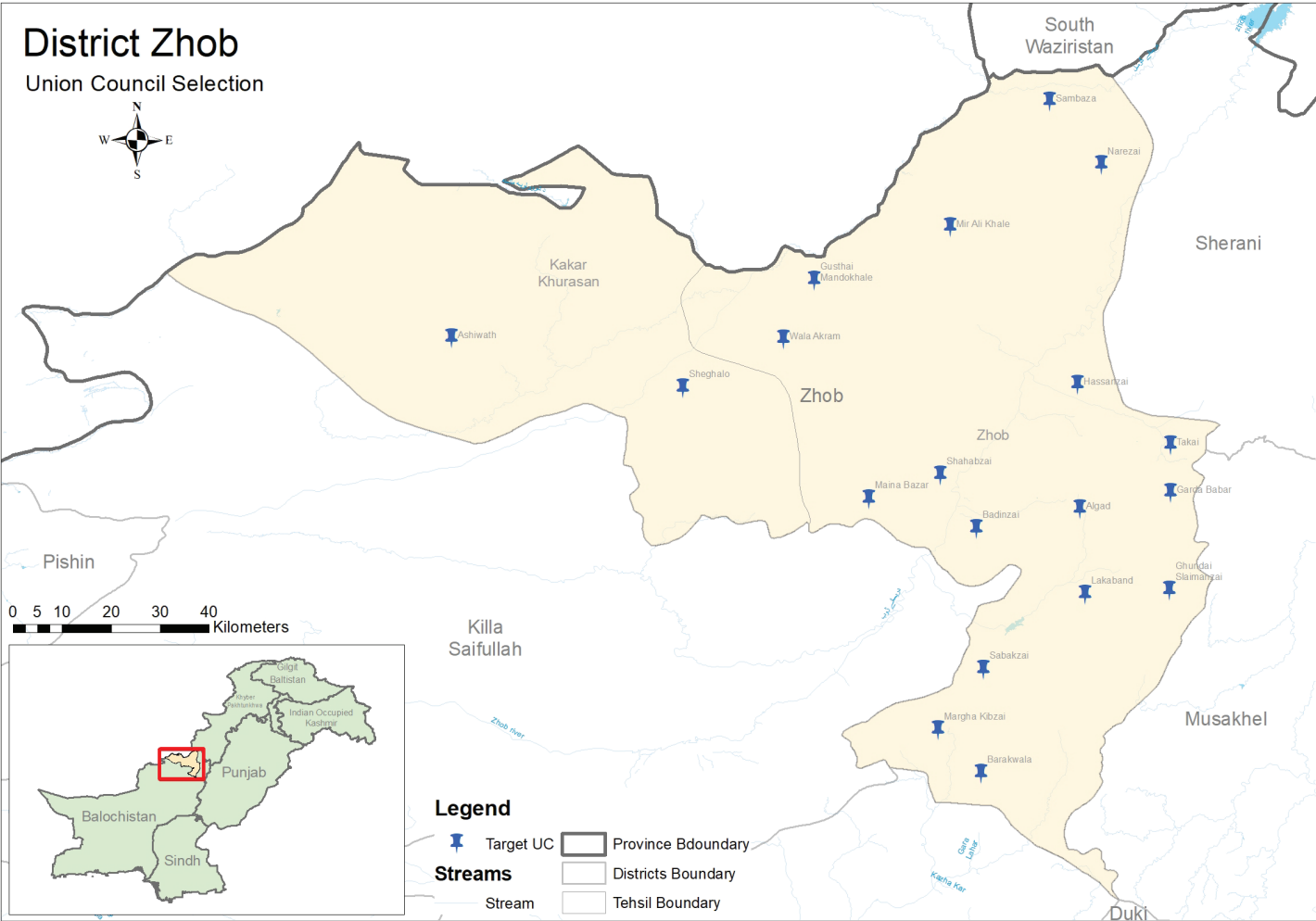

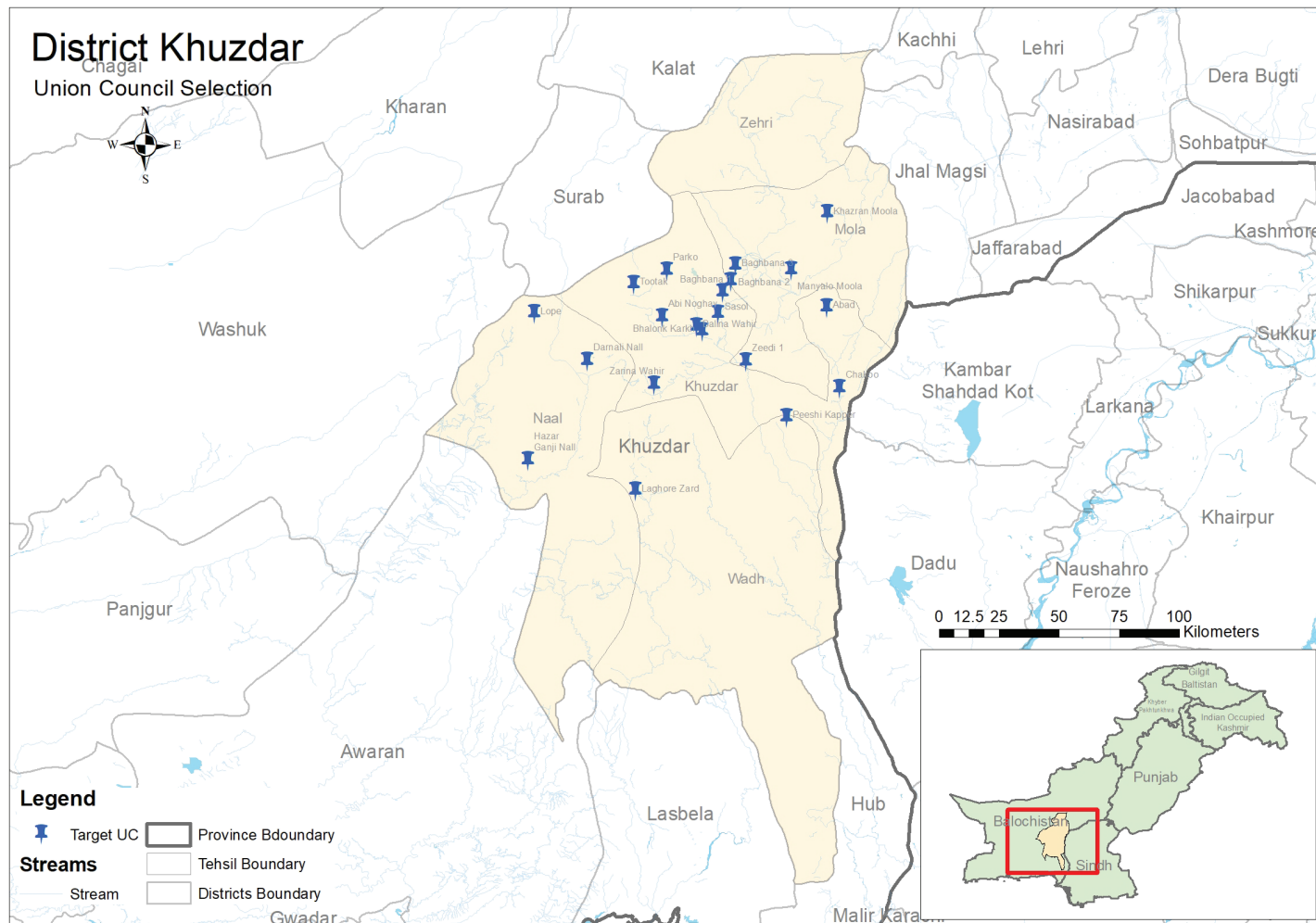
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
